Minutes from last meeting were reviewed. Motion made by Barry and 2nd by John. All in favor. Motion carried.

FINANCIAL REPORT.

Members reviewed Financial Report. Motion made by Barry and 2nd by John. All in favor. Motion carried.

BILLS

Members reviewed the bill order #6 for 38,733.24 Motion by John and 2nd by Barry. All in favor. Motion carried.

WATER PLANT OPERATOR REPORT.

Rich reported 5,761,228 gallons for the month of June, 192,000 gallons per day of water. The reservoir is 90% full. The mine spring is overflowing. Possible water leak on 2" line on High Street near trailer park. Line was traced back, found no leak. A new printer was purchased and installed at water plant. On the evening of June 20th there was a brown out followed by a loss of power causing some blown fuses at the plant. Rich made the repairs. A chlorine gas detector was purchased and installed at the water plant. Detector is operational. A 6" main valve needs replaced supplying water to the nursing home. To change 6" valve a 10 valve needs turned off. This will shut water off to the majority of the industrial park. This work will need scheduled in advance, do to operational needs.

ENGINEERING REPORT.

The proposal to abandon the well at the park has been submitted. Permitting fee through Stiffler & McGraw is \$4,400. This work will need a certified driller and the pump will be pulled. Motion to close the well made by Barry and 2nd by Jim. All in favor, motion carried. Tobias is working on the report for the filter bed evaluation.

OTHER BUSINESS

Bridge Street waster line project, permit application was submitted. If sidewalks are removed during project they will need to ADA compliant when replaced. M&M Concrete will do this work. An extension for the pool grant was requested.
